RESOLUTION NO. 1-2025

(July 8, 2025)

RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE TERM OF OFFICE FROM TWO (2) TO FOUR (4) YEARS
FOR MAYOR AND TRUSTEES AND PROVIDING FOR BIENNIAL ELECTIONS FOR SAID
OFFICE ON THE EVEN NUMBERED YEARS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wyoming has determined it would be in the best interest of the Village of Wyoming to extend the term of the Mayor and Trustees from two years to four years; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wyoming has further determined that it would be in the best interest of the Village of Wyoming to hold biennial elections for the office of Mayor and all Village Trustees; and

WHEREAS, Village Law, §3-302 authorizes the Board of Trustees to adopt a resolution, subject to permissive referendum at least 30 days prior to a general election extending the terms of Mayor and all Village Trustees from two years to four years and further authorizes the Board of Trustees to include in such a resolution, a provision making the general elections for the terms of office of Mayor and all Village Trustees to be held biennially on the odd or even numbered years, as the Board of Trustees shall determine.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Sarah Buczek which has been duly seconded by Scott McCumiskey, it is now hereby

RESOLVED, that the term of office of the elected Mayor of the Village of Wyoming and the office of all Trustees of the Village of Wyoming shall be four years, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the general election for the Village of Wyoming for the office of Mayor the office of all Village Trustees shall be held hence forth as biennial elections to be held on the even numbered years; and it be further

RESOLVED, that this resolution is adopted subject to a permissive referendum; and it be further

RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk is hereby directed to place an abstract of the resolution in the newspaper having general circulation within the Village within ten days of the adoption of this resolution; and to post the abstract of the resolution to the Village sign board and website immediately, which must remain there for at least 15 days.
